

**NOMINATION FORM FOR AT-LARGE MEMBER

At the Forty-first Annual Convention, one Lay Communicant in Good Standing of the Church, at least 18 years of age resident in the Diocese and not a member of the Cathedral, will be elected to the Cathedral Committee for a term expiring on the adjournment of the Convention in 2024. The Cathedral Committee is responsible for planning, funding, staffing and managing, in consultation with Cathedral and Diocesan staff, the Diocesan services, events and programs at the Cathedral.

A biography, including history of service in the church, of no more than 150 words should be completed in the space at the end of this form. **Once the form is completed, please click on "Submit" to submit the form online. If not submitted online, this form (including the biography) should be printed and emailed to diocese@episwtn.org.** Nominations received by **5 p.m. on November 4, 2022** will be included in the Convention Booklet. If not received by November 4, a fully completed nomination form must be submitted online or by email to salexander@episwtn.org no later than **noon on the day before the first day of Convention for the nominee to be included on the ballot.**
