Description of Disciplinary Board

The Disciplinary Board is the group of Clergy and Lay persons which receives information and makes decisions when a member of the Clergy is accused of misconduct.

The nominator shall obtain the nominee’s consent to nomination and the nominee shall consent to the nomination by signing below. A biography, including history of service in the church, of no more than 150 words should be completed in the space at the end of this form. **Once the form is completed, please click on “Submit” to submit the form online. If not submitted online, this form (including the biography) should be printed and emailed to diocese@episwtn.org.** Nominations received by **5 p.m. on November 4, 2022** will be included in the Convention Booklet. If not received by November 4, a fully completed nomination form must be submitted online or by email to salexander@episwtn.org no later than **noon on the day before the first day of Convention for the nominee to be included on the ballot.**
