FOUR CLERGY DEPUTIES AND FOUR CLERGY ALTERNATE DEPUTIES

The Forty-first Convention will elect four Clergy Deputies and four Clergy Alternate Deputies to the 81st General Convention late June 2024 or early July 2024, in Louisville, KY. Requirements for nomination: The Clergy must be canonically resident in the Diocese of West Tennessee and must agree to attend informational meetings and review materials in preparation for the General Convention, as well as attend Province IV Synod meetings and the entirety of the 81st General Convention.

Canon 8, Section 1

The nominator shall obtain the nominee's consent to nomination and the nominee shall consent to the nomination by signing below. A biography, including history of service in the church, of no more than 150 words should be completed in the space at the end of this form. **Once the form is completed, please click on "Submit" to submit the form online. If not submitted online, this form (including the biography) should be printed and emailed to diocese@episwtn.org. Nominations received by 5 p.m. on November 4, 2022 will be included in the Convention Booklet. If not received by November 4, a fully completed nomination form must be submitted online or by email to salexander@episwtn.org no later than noon on the day before the first day of Convention for the nominee to be included on the ballot.**
