

NOMINATION FORM FOR DEPUTIES TO GENERAL CONVENTION:

FOUR LAY DEPUTIES AND TWO LAY ALTERNATE DEPUTIES

The 44th Convention will elect four Lay Deputies and two Lay Alternate Deputies to the 82nd General Convention which will be held July 3-8, 2027, in Phoenix, Arizona.

Requirements for nomination (Canon 8, Sec. 1):

1. The nominee must be at least 18 years old.
2. A Confirmed Communicant in Good Standing in this Diocese.
3. The nominee must agree to attend informational meetings and to review materials in preparation for the General Convention, as well as to attend Province IV Synod meetings and the entirety of the 82nd General Convention.

In addition, the nominee must fulfill all requirements set forth for deputies by the General Convention Office which could include intercultural competency training.

The nominator shall obtain the nominee's consent to nomination, and the nominee shall consent to the nomination by signing below. A biography, including the history of service in the church, of no more than 150 words, should be completed in the space at the end of this form.
